

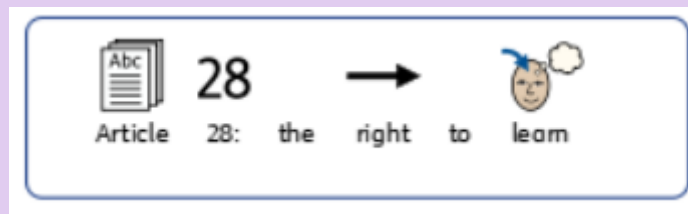
**Welcome to Autumn 1!**

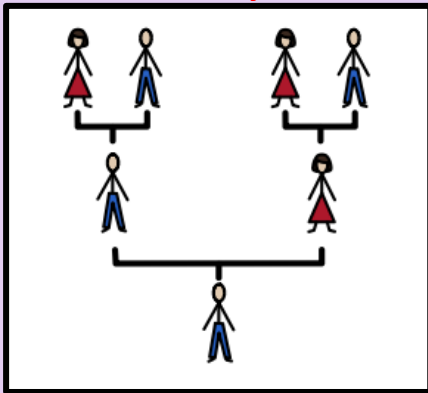



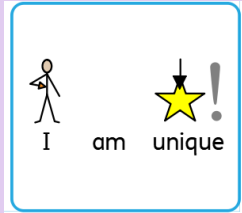
## Home Learning Tasks

*Discussion questions:*

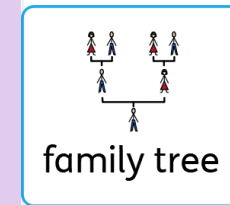
- What type of home do you live in?

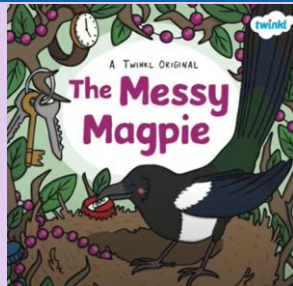
### Week 4- Recycle week

*Discussion questions:*

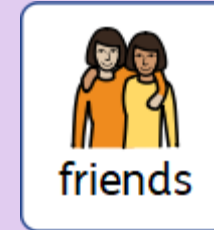
- What seasons are we in now?
