

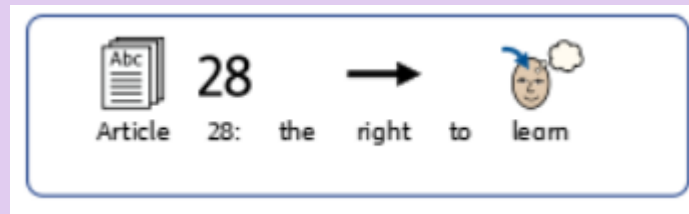
Welcome to Autumn 2!

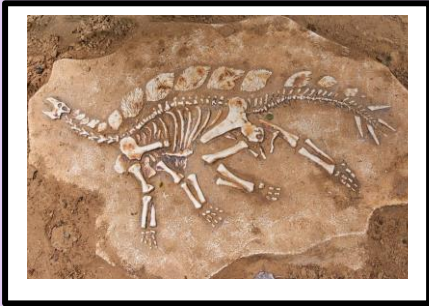

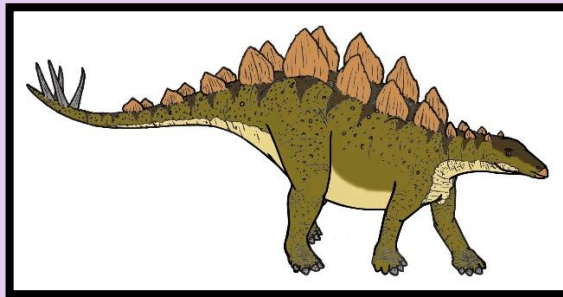

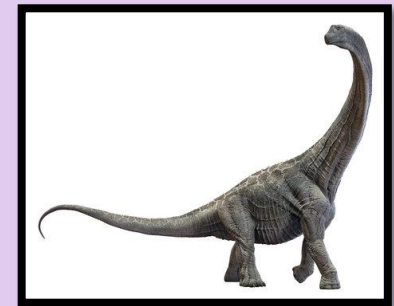

A special kind of animal that lived on land a long time ago.



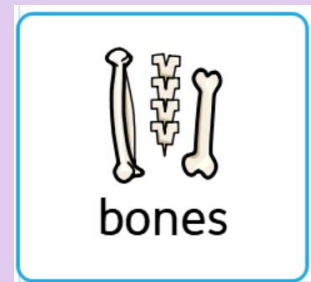
No longer alive we cannot see them in the world we live in.

Fossils are remains or traces of plants and animals that lived long ago.




