

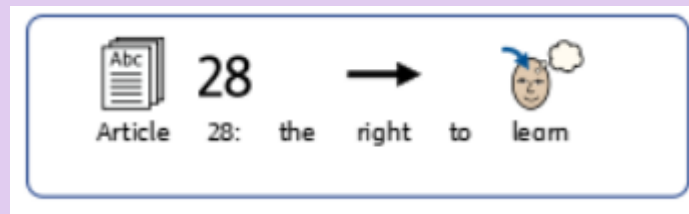
Welcome to Autumn 2!
